I will respect the property of the bus operator at all times (eg refraining)	from standing
on seats or vandalising the vehicle in any way).	

- I will not engage in any behaviour that could put the driver or other students at risk.
- I will observe the requirements and instructions of the bus driver and the teacher/s responsible for bus duty at all times.

The safety and comfort of everyone on the bus depends on a standard of behaviour and consideration for others that is expected in the classroom. We hope that caregivers will support the school in maintaining these standards of behaviour.

IF THIS CODE OF CONDUCT IS BROKEN:

- The student will be placed on daily report for one week and the caregiver will be notified immediately.
- If no improvement is evident after one week, an interview will be arranged between the student, caregiver(s), and school.
- If there is still no improvement, the privilege to travel on a school bus will be withdrawn, and the caregiver will be required to find alternative transport to get the student to school.
- In extreme cases of misbehaviour, the privilege of travelling on a school bus could be withdrawn immediately.

Enrolling for Bus Transport Service

All Students that are to travel by bus, on either of our two bus routes, will be required to enroll online before they can be considered eligible to be transported to and from Dorie School.

Eligibility for free bus service will be determined by:

Distance from Dorie School:

If you are in years 1 – 8 and live more than 3.2kms from the nearest appropriate school

Distance to other schools:

If you live in an area that is the Transport Entitlement Zone (TEZ) of a neighboring school then you may still be eligible to travel on a Dorie School bus providing you pay \$60/child/term and there is an agreement with the neighboring school

You are entitled to attend any school of your choice but not entitled to:

- Be collected inside the TEZ of another school
- Be collected from outside your home (this is determined by the current bus route)
- Free transport to a school that you are not residing in the TEZ of

Once you have ticked "I agree" to the terms and conditions you will then be required to fill out your child's details which include:

- Name, Date of Birth, Address (which must include rapid number), school, year level etc.
- Bus route name (we have two, Kyle and Dorie, contact the school if you are unsure which bus route you are closest to)
- When you will be using the bus ie which term, days and time.
- Caregiver details
- Once you have completed this online page, click the submit button.
- Repeat for each child.

Payment details will then follow.
